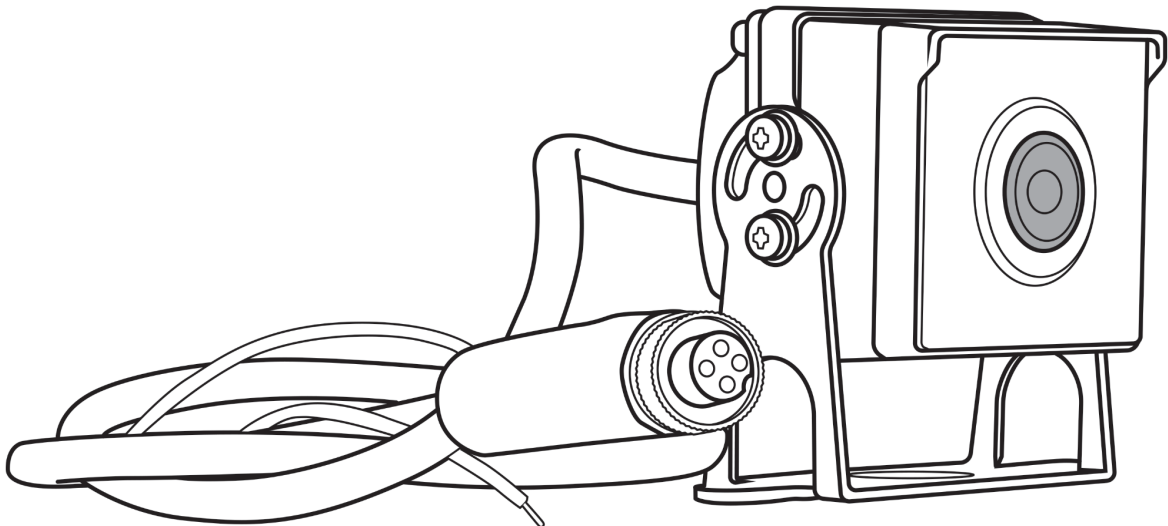

Aerpro Advanced Safety Vision Cameras are engineered to enhance driving safety by providing clear, high-quality images of the surrounding environment. Designed to minimise blind spots, these cameras improve situational awareness and assist with vehicle manoeuvring.

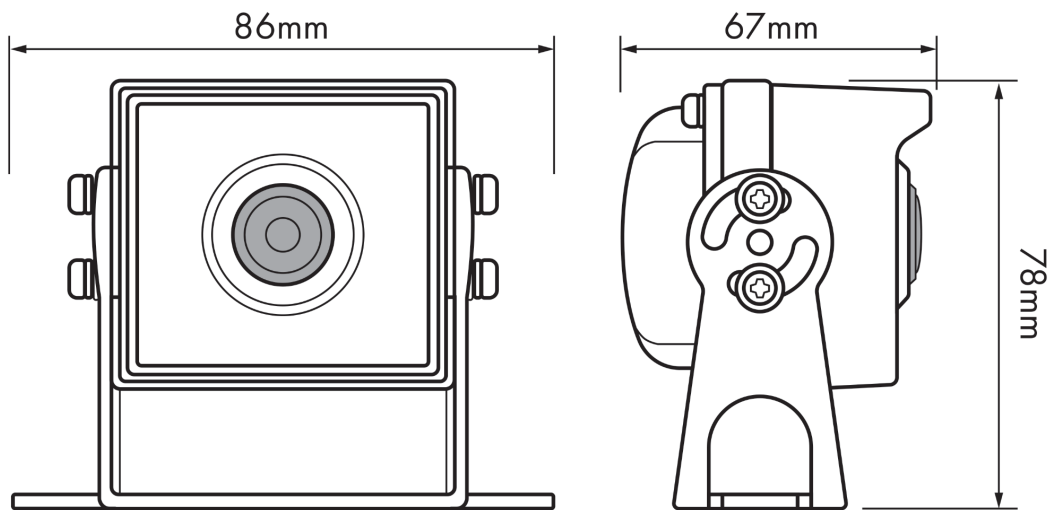
Before installing or using your Aerpro camera, please read this manual carefully to ensure proper setup and operation. Select a suitable mounting location based on your specific application, and before drilling, check for any wiring harnesses, hoses, or pipes behind the panel to prevent damage.

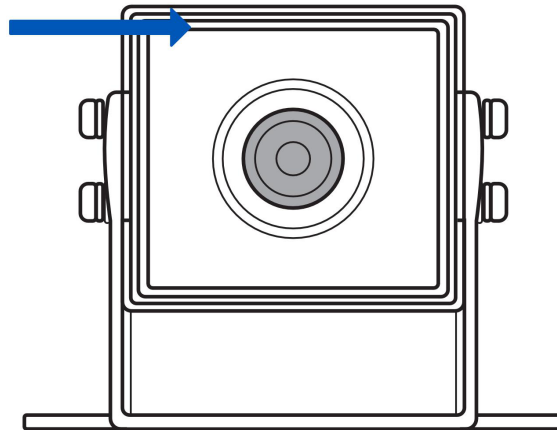
Installation Guide

Safety Precautions

- Ensure the vehicle is turned off before installation.
- Avoid installing the camera near high-temperature areas.
- Secure all cables properly to avoid interference with moving parts.

Camera Viewing Angle and Orientation

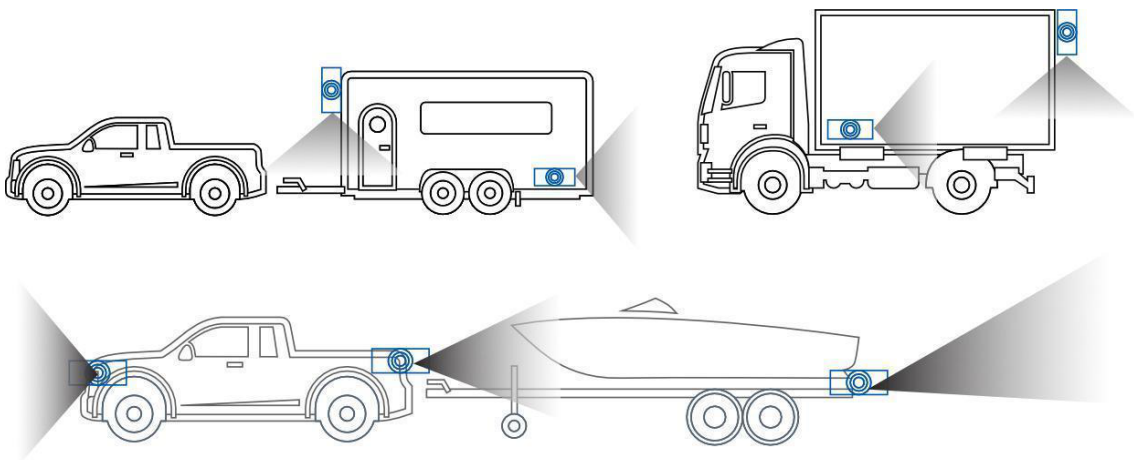
- The camera should be adjusted to provide a **140° (H) viewing angle** for optimal visibility.
- Avoid obstructions that may block the camera's field of view.
- Route cables along the vehicle's existing wire channels, where possible to, prevent damage.
- The correct orientation is determined by positioning the visor towards the sky.



Camera Placement

- Mount the camera on the side or rear of the vehicle using the included side mount for an optimal view.
- Ensure the camera lens is angled properly to capture a full side or rear view.

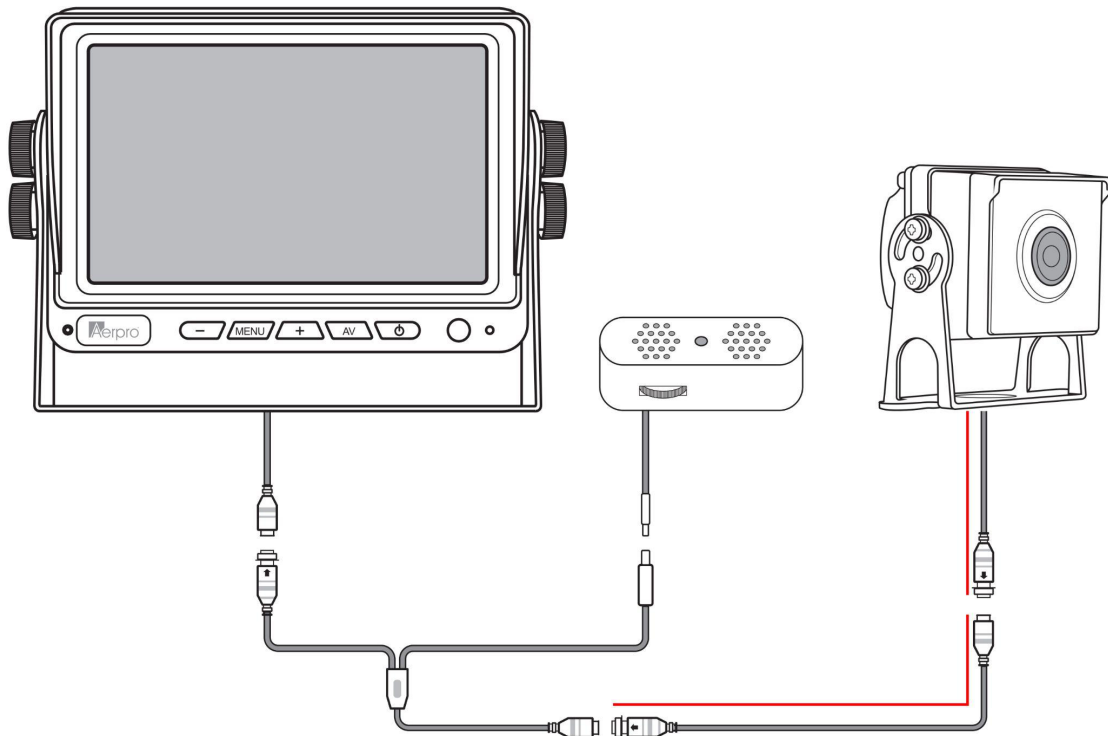
Note: The correct orientation is determined by positioning the visor towards the sky - refer to Camera Viewing Angle and Orientation above.



Note: Above images are examples of where the camera can be installed.

Wiring Instructions

1. Connect the power cable to the vehicle's power system (12V or 24V DC).
2. Route the video cable to the dashboard monitor.
3. Connect the red reverse trigger wire to reverse to power the radar function.
4. Secure all connections and test the camera before finalizing installation.
5. Use cable clips to secure the wires and prevent loose connections.
6. Route cables along the vehicle's existing wire channels, where possible to, prevent damage.
7. To change video quality remove the jumper link for 1080p or jumper connect 720p.



Note: This camera is supplied as a camera only with a 50cm cable. Extension cables and monitors are sold separately. The following wiring diagram illustrates the complete camera system.

Note: Extension cables available AVEC3, AVEC5, AVEC10, AVEC15 and AVEC20.

Maintenance & Care

- Regularly clean the camera lens for clear visibility.
- Avoid exposing the camera to excessive force or impact.
- Check and secure all wiring connections periodically.

Troubleshooting

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
No image on the screen	Loose or disconnected wiring	Check and secure all wiring connections
	No 12volt blown fuse	Inspect and replace fuse if necessary
	Camera not operating	Test with another camera if possible
	Malfunctioning display	Test display with another input source
Flickering or distorted image	Loose connections	Tighten all connections
	Interference from other electronics	Keep wiring away from high-power cables
	Low voltage	Check battery and alternator output
Blurry or unclear image	Dirty camera lens	Clean the lens with a microfiber cloth
	Condensation inside lens	Allow to dry or replace camera
	Camera misalignment	Adjust camera angle
Blank screen with guidelines	No video signal	Check RCA or digital video connection
	Defective camera sensor	Refer to warranty terms for replacement
Camera works intermittently	Loose or corroded wiring	Inspect and repair connections
	Weak power supply	Test with direct battery connection
No night vision	IR LEDs not working (Functions only at night)	Refer to warranty terms for replacement
	Poor ground connection	Ensure solid ground wiring
